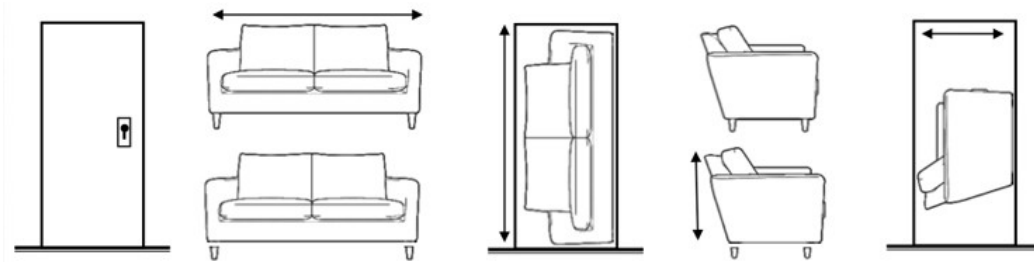


Will your sofa fit?

Before you order your sofa you need to be sure that it will fit in to your home. There are a few things to consider:

1. Are your doors wide enough? The height of the sofa is always the smallest dimension, generally the easiest way of getting a sofa in is on its back. If the door is wider than the height of the sofa it will go in.
2. Are your doors high enough? Sometimes it will be necessary to stand a sofa on its end to get it in, if the door is higher than the length of the sofa it will fit through.



3. Do you have any radiators, light fittings or fixed in furniture that might impede access? Especially in narrow hallways.
4. Does the sofa you have chosen have high or low arms? Low arms can sometimes be useful so that you can use the L of the sofa to feed it through doorways.
5. If your sofa needs to be lifted over anything, do you have the ceiling height to do this?
6. If your sofa is going upstairs, is there a landing that needs negotiating? If it needs to be lifted over a banister, do you have the ceiling clearance?
7. Outside - are we able to get through any narrow gates?
9. Would it be easier to take your sofa in through a window?
10. Some of our sofas can be made with removeable legs, if you require them please discuss this with a member of our team.
